Let's Celebrate!

Thursday 9th June was Empathy Day. Empathy is the ability to understand and share the feelings of others.

Discuss: Supporting other people's emotions and reacting in an appropriate way makes people feel listened to. In turn, we feel good that we've been able to empathise and support someone else.

Do: KS1 - Give the children different scenarios (e.g. a friend was excited about receiving a gift, someone was crying) and ask them how they would react. They could show you appropriate facial expressions, body language or tell you phrases they might use.

KS2 - Give the children different scenarios to role play in pairs (e.g. someone doesn't do as well as they hoped on a test, someone has an injury, someone comes first in a race). Ask them to respond to each other in an attentive manner, ask appropriate questions and be supportive.

Reflect: How does it feel to be able to support someone else? Can you think of a time when you showed empathy? Is it always easy for everyone to empathise?


