Congratulations to the Headteacher, all staff and pupils. I am sure you will wish to join with me in offering congratulations to the school.

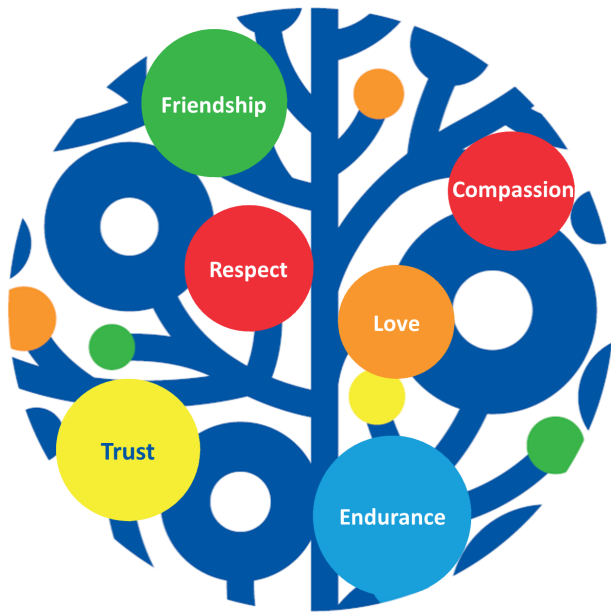
