- Learning about how humans have evolved differently from one another

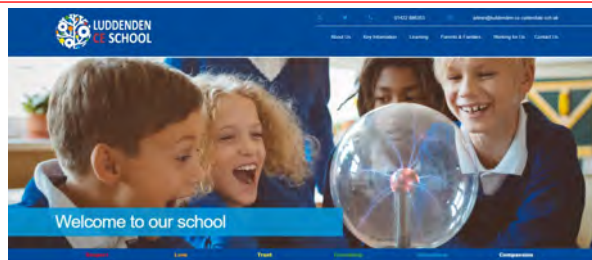
